ACT 182 of 2009 requires an Arkansas four-year public institution of higher education to admit a transfer student to junior status in a baccalaureate degree program if that student has completed the approved Associate of Arts or Associate of Science transfer curriculum.

Note: Students not meeting the ACT or equivalent requirements in math and English must enroll in sequential academic skills math, reading, and/or English courses during their first or second semester in college and each subsequent semester until the requirements are successfully completed.
