# Program/Graduation Requirements and Admission Criteria:

- Students should check their chosen program's description in the current catalog for possible prerequisite courses and course sequencing.
- Human A&P I and II should be taken at the same institution. If taken at different institutions, students will have to go through approval with the Dean of Health Professions before it can be accepted. Students completing BIOL 24004 and/or BIOL 24104 can acquire more points towards the program admissions due to credit hours and these courses also count towards the ARNEC program.
- When transferring Math for Health Professions be sure to make sure it is not coming in as Math for Nurses.
- Students will be required to attend mandatory orientation prior to the start date of the program.
- Once in the practical nursing program, a minimum of 2.5 GPA is required.

## Admission Criteria

Applicants should complete and submit a Practical Nursing Program Application online at <u>www.uaht.edu</u> and submit copies of college transcript directly to the Practical Nursing Program Coordinator in addition to an official transcript submitted to the College's Admission Office.

Minimum admission standards for PN Program:

- 1. Complete Admission to UAHT
- 2. Minimum scores: Reading and English Equivalent of ACT 19 or completion of remedial class(es).
- 3. Completion of NLN PAX Entrance Exam. The PAX exam can be taken once each application period, but students are responsible for sending their highest score.
- 4. Must meet the essential functions and technical standards required for nursing.
- 5. A felony or misdemeanor conviction may prevent you from receiving licensure and/or completing clinical requirements
- 6. Prerequisites/General Education requirements must be completed before or during application period with a grade of a C or better.
- 7. Students who have been previously enrolled in a nursing or health related program must contact the Program Director.

Note: The UAHT PN Program cannot accept Louisiana residents, as the UAHT PN program does not meet Louisiana Board of Nursing educational requirements.

To apply for the Practical Nursing Program,

- DAY Program Hope Campus: Apply from March 1 through May 1. Program starts in June (Summer I)
- EVENING Program Texarkana Campus: Apply from September 1 through November 1. Program starts in January (Spring)
